2. Detailed resume or curriculum vitae, including relevant human rights experience and studies.
3. Official university transcript(s).
4. A personal statement (maximum 1000 words) about the applicant's relevant experience, interest, and future aspirations with respect to human rights work. The statement should include a discussion of how the Fellowship aligns with the applicant's career plans.
5. An project statement (maximum 750 words) that serves as a project proposal or statement of interest specifying particular thematic or regional interests and proposed areas of work for both fellowship placements.
6. Two or three letters of recommendation, at least one from a professor familiar with the applicant's studies.

Deadline for applications is February 1, 2008.
